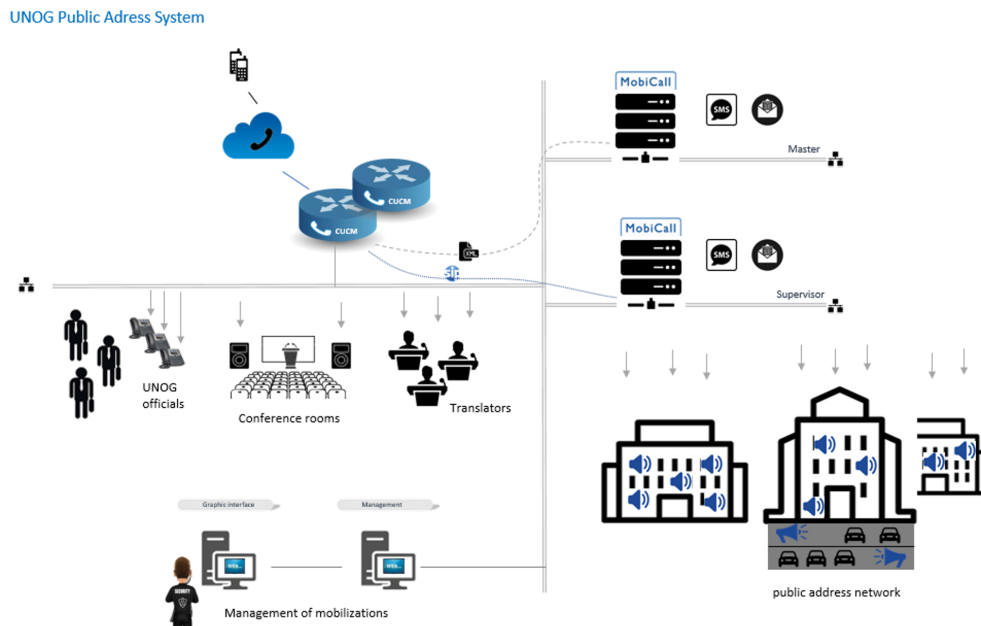


PAS (Public Address System) solution at the UN in Geneva



New Voice presents the PAS (Public Address System) solution in operation at the UN in Geneva.

With this solution implemented in 2006 with a TDM PBX, then upgraded in 2015 to a VoIP network, it is possible to send evacuation (or confinement) messages by voice and text very quickly to several hundred stations simultaneously. This is thanks to the MobiCall technology and its integration with Cisco's CUCM.

The solution works in combination with the UN directory database in order to reach the thousands of officials on the site.

Mobilizations are controlled via a graphical interface allowing evacuation of the site by buildings, by floors, by offices according to needs.

For greater efficiency, the messages transmitted on the civil servants' telephone terminals are relayed on hundreds of loudspeakers, controlled by MobiCall, and distributed in the corridors and basements of the buildings.

The fully redundant MobiCall hot stand-by solution created by NewVoice ensures the safety of people and property since 1991.
